Solar panel installation costs a national average of \$16,500 for a 6kW solar panel system for a 1,500 square ft. home. The price per watt for solar panels can range from \$2.50 to \$3.50, and largely depends on the home's geographical area. Residential solar panels are usually sized at 3kW to 8kW and can cost anywhere from \$9,255 and \$28,000 in total installation costs.

By 2010, countries like Germany, Spain, and China had more than 40 million kilowatts of solar power. The price for using solar energy dropped a lot. Heading into 2024, solar panels can account for about 13% of the total project cost, while inverters and balance of system (BOS) equipment account for 33% of the total cost of an average project. The majority of the project cost goes toward soft costs, including labor, permitting, overhead, and profit, which we'll explore below.

The cost of operating new solar power plants in the country is now almost equal to the cost of operating coal-fired power plants, at around EUR 32 / MWh. According to BNEF reports, the cheapest photovoltaic projects financed in the first six months of 2020 should reach LCOE in the range of 21-27 EUR / MWh.
